

i-ALERT Mobile App Privacy Statement

OVERVIEW AND DOCUMENT SCOPE

The i-ALERT Mobile App is a tool for collecting, viewing, and analyzing i-ALERT data.

This document is a Privacy Statement outlining the collection and handling of your personal data as a user of i-ALERT Mobile App.

Note this document does not cover sensor data. Handling of sensor data is covered in i-ALERT Mobile App Terms of Service.

WHAT DO WE COLLECT?

Our Company collects the following data:

- Your Email Address. Required for logging into i-ALERT Mobile App and if you decide to receive optional notifications. Provided by you during the first use of the i-ALERT Mobile App.
- 2. Your alternative Email Address. Optional
- 3. Your First Name and Last Name. Required for access to i-ALERT Mobile App.
- 4. Your Company Name. Optional.
- 5. Your Title. Optional.
- 6. Your Phone Number. Optional.
- 7. Your Alternative Phone Number. Optional

How Do We Collect Your Data?

You directly provide most of the data Our Company collects. We collect and process your data when you:

1. Register for i-ALERT Mobile App access.

HOW WILL WE USE YOUR DATA?

Our Company collects your data for:

- 1. Manage your i-ALERT Mobile App account and access.
- 2. Email you with optional notifications.
- 3. Email you with reports and analysis results, if included in your service level.

How Do We Store Your Data?

Our Company securely stores your data in a database that is encrypted via TLS in-transit and atrest using AES-256.

Our Company will keep your data for the duration of your i-ALERT Mobile App service contract. Upon the conclusion or termination of your i-ALERT Mobile App service contract, we will delete your personal data within 30 days of conclusion or termination. We delete your personal data by clearing all the personal data defined above associated with your i-ALERT Mobile App username in the above-mentioned database.

WHAT ARE YOUR DATA PROTECTION RIGHTS?

Your Data Protection Rights are important to us. Every i-ALERT Mobile App User has the following

Data Protection Rights:

1. The Right to Access (GDPR Article 15): You have the right to request Our Company for

copies of your personal data.

2. The Right to Rectification (GDPR Article 16): You have the right to request Our Company

correct any of your personal data information you feel is inaccurate. You have the right

to request Our Company to complete any of your personal data information you feel is

incomplete.

3. The Right to Erasure (GDPR Article 17): You have the right to request Our Company

erase/delete any of your personal data, under certain conditions defined in GDPR.

4. The Right to Restricted Processing (GDPR Article 18): You have the right to request Our

Company restrict processing of any of your information Our Company has collected to

another organization or directly to you, under certain conditions defined in GDPR.

5. The Right to Data Portability (GDPR Article 20): You have the right to request Our

Company transfer your personal data, under certain conditions defined in GDPR.

6. The Right to Object to Processing (GDPR Article 21): You have the right to object to Our

Company processing any of your personal data, under certain conditions defined in GDPR.

Our Company has 30 days to respond to your request related to your Data Protection Rights. If
